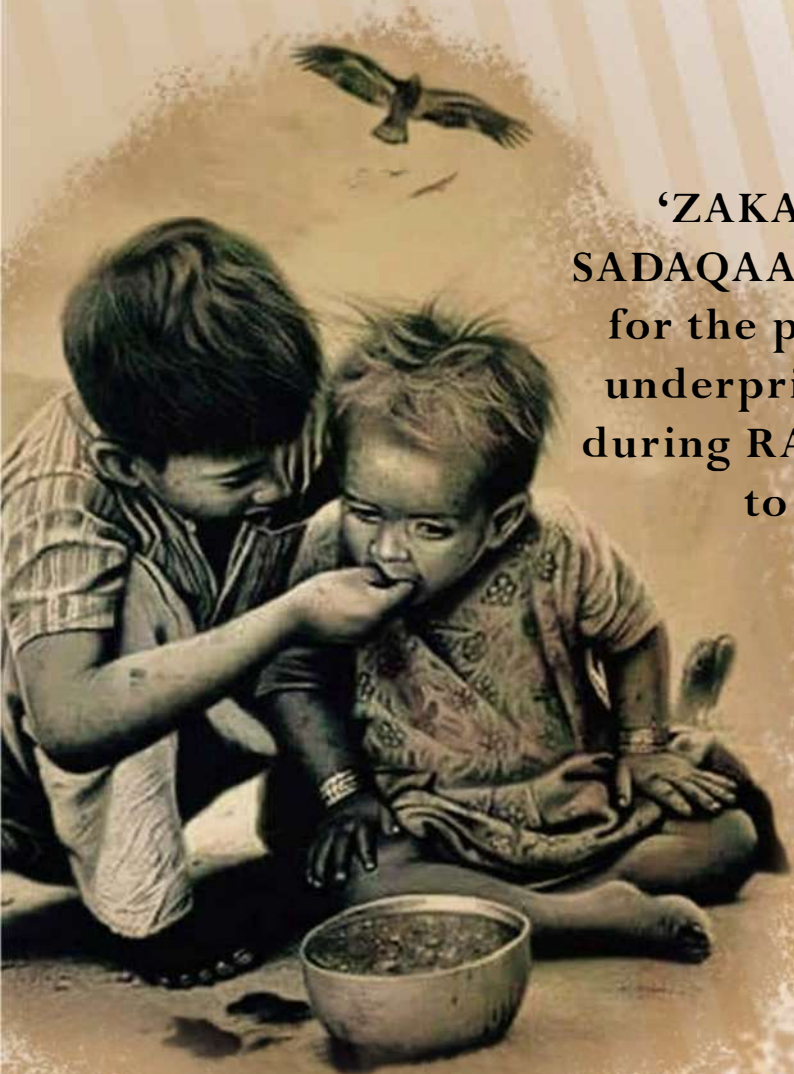

Healthcare and Meeting the Needs of the Deprived

MANDATE OF ALI AKBAR KHAN FOUNDATION

1. Envisaged mandate of Ali Akbar Khan Foundation (AAKF) is to provide for the basic healthcare and medical needs, free of cost, to the poor, needy, deprived and the under-privileged classes of the society. Ali Akbar Medical Centre (AAMC) houses the medical facilities (medical centre/dispensary) and looks after only outdoor patients.
2. In due course, depending on availability of resources, however, we may be able to create the much-needed facility in rural areas, a small gynaecology set-up with a dedicated operation room and 1-2 room (s) indoor-ward looked after by a lady doctor.

MEDICAL AND HEALTHCARE

3. Quality of Treatment Vis-à-Vis Daily Patient Strength

Daily average has now 'Masha-Allah' increased to almost 180-200 patients per day. Attitude, conduct vis-à-vis behavior, and handling of patients by the Doctor is good, which has greatly contributed towards satisfaction and contentment of patients with the treatment provided at the AAMC.

4. Donation of Very High-Quality Medicines on Gratis by Hilton Pharma

Very high-quality medicines are being donated to AAKF by the renowned and the esteemed Karachi based medicine manufacturing company, Hilton Pharma (Private) Limited since the Year 2016. This factor has been of singular importance towards increase in the daily outdoor patients' strength. Medicines, valued at Rs.3,330,626.00 (Rupees three million three hundred thirty thousand six hundred and twenty-six), have been donated by the esteemed Hilton Pharma since 01 July, 2021 till date. Since the Year 2016 till date, the total value of the medicines donated by them amounts to Rs.22,902,746.00 (Rupees twenty-two million nine hundred two thousand seven hundred and forty-six).

5. Donation of High-Quality Medicines on Gratis by Medi-Bank Trust

High-quality medicines valued at Rs.486,141.00 (Rupees four hundred eighty-six thousand one hundred and forty-one) were donated on one-time basis during the Year 2020-2021 by Medi-Bank Trust, a Lahore based NGO (Non-Government Organization), which were well utilized at the AAMC.

6. Procurement of Medicines Ex-Local Trade

Medicines, valued at Rs.442,088.00 (Rupees four hundred forty-two thousand and eighty eight), were procured by the AAMC ex-local trade since 01 July, 2021 till date. Since the Year 2010-2011 till date, medicines procured by the AAMC ex-local trade amounts to Rs. 5,135,100.00 (Rupees five million one hundred thirty-five thousand and one hundred).

7. Overall AAMC Expenditure

Since 01 July, 2021 till date, Rs.2,649,542.00 (Rupees two million six hundred forty nine thousand five hundred and forty two) have been expended on the AAMC. The total expenditure since inception (Year 2010-2011) till date amounts to Rs.24,180,798.00 (Rupees twenty-four million one hundred eighty thousand seven hundred and ninety-eight).

8. Patient Feedback

Visiting patients reportedly go back fully satisfied and contented with the treatment (and medicines) given to them and the conduct and behavior of the Doctor and the AAMC Medical and Administrative Staff. We are very happy and satisfied as well on this account.

MULTIFARIOUS CHARITABLE-WELFARE ACTIVITIES

9. Education Sponsorship and Stipends

We have started sponsoring education of talented and selected students at various institutions of learning (school, college and higher education) since 01 July, 2021. Three (03) students, one studying at the Faisalabad National Textile University, the other undergoing Chartered Accountancy Certification, and the third is a college student, are being supported, at the present. We intend spending a total of up to Rs.2.0 Million (Rupees two million) on sponsorship of education (school, college and higher seats of learning) during the next three to five (3-5) years. Till date we have invested Rs.1,431,925.00 (Rupees one million four hundred thirty-one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five) towards promotion of education. We will, hopefully, increase the amount substantially in the future, depending on availability of resources.

10. Dry Rations, Fresh Meat and Cooked Food-Meals

The total amount utilized since the Year 2010-2011 till date amounts to Rs.7,646,009.00 (Rupees seven million six hundred forty-six thousand and nine). Though allocation of the above-mentioned amount, we certainly do not consider adequate in view of the economic hardship being faced by the poor due to the prevalent economic environment vis-à-vis rising costs and inflation. At the present, however, we are unable to spare more funds towards these areas of concern. Hopefully, we shall perform better in the future.

11. Subsistence-Sustenance Allowance and Monetary Assistance

Whenever possible, we support people in need of monetary assistance, which is not 'Qarza-e-Hasna'. Since the Year 2010-2011, we have provided Rs.7,915,888.00 (Rupees seven million nine hundred fifteen thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight) to various people to set-up some small business ventures to earn their livelihood and sustain their families.

12. Warm Clothing and Blankets for Winters and Light Clothing for Summers

We have only been able to provide limited support to people. Our total assistance to cover the previous years and the period, 01 July, 2021 to 30 June, 2022, is likely to be only Rs.1.0 Million (Rupees one million). We hope and pray to Allah Almighty that we perform better in the future.

13. 'Qarza-e-Hasna'

Since the Year 2018, we have provided 'Qarza-e-Hasna' amounting to approximately Rs.2.0 Million (Rupees two million) to eight (08) people for their essential needs. Return of the 'Qarza' by each is spread over a fairly long period of time through affordable and easy installments each month. This is considered a useful scheme to alleviate financial problems of various kinds, faced by people. We hope to not only continue with this 'Qarza-e-Hasna' facility, but also to make efforts to enlarge and widen the AAKF capacity and scope to enable more people to be benefited from this scheme.

14. Renovation of Houses

During this financial year, we have so far been able to provide Rs.45,000.00 (Rupees forty-five thousand) to one needy person. Since 2010-2011 till date, Rs.1,360,000 (Rupees one million three hundred and sixty thousand) have been expended towards this welfare measure.

15. Assistance for Marriages

Since 2010-2011, we have provided Rs.1,558,100.00 (Rupees one million five hundred fifty-eight thousand and one hundred) to the needy on their marriages.

16. Expenditure on 'Masajid'

Rs.886,800.00 (Rupees eight hundred eighty-six thousand and eight hundred) have been expended on improvement, development, construction and maintenance of 'Masajid' since the Year 2012.

17. Individually Displaced Persons (IDPs), North Waziristan

Rs.300,000.00 (Rupees three hundred thousand) were contributed towards rehabilitation of the IDPs of North Waziristan, in support of the campaign launched by the Government of Pakistan, during the Year 2014-2015.

18. Donation to Flood Affected People in Southern Punjab

Rs.300,000.00 (Rupees three hundred thousand) were contributed towards rehabilitation of the flood affected people in Southern Punjab during the Year 2014-2015.

19. Printing and Distribution of QURANIC SIPARAAHS, PUNJ-SURAHS, QURANIC DUAS and Islamic Literature

- a. **South Africa.** Rs.69,500.00 (Rupees sixty-nine thousand and five hundred) during the period, 2018-2020.
- b. **Pakistan.** Rs.1,379,300.00 (Rupees one million three hundred seventy-nine thousand and three hundred) during the period, 2016-2021.

20. Miscellaneous Projects

Rs.1,450,000.00 (Rupees one million four hundred and fifty thousand) were donated to the following charity organizations:

- a. Khadija Memorial Trust Hospital, Faisalabad. Rs.700,000.00 (Rupees seven hundred thousand) during the period, 2013-2015.
- b. National Women Uplift Association (NWUA), Rawalpindi Cantonment. Rs.250,000.00 (Rupees two hundred and fifty thousand) during the period, 2012-2014.
- c. PAKEEZAH Charity and Welfare Organization, Lahore. Rs.300,000.00 (Rupees three hundred thousand) since August, 2021 till date. We hope to continue donating Rs.50,000.00 (Rupees fifty thousand) per month in the future as well.
- d. SABA Aslam Education and Welfare Trust, Rawalpindi. Rs.100,000.00 (Rupees one hundred thousand) during the period, 2011-2012.
- e. Donation Towards Diamer-Bhasha and Mohmand Dams Fund. Rs.100,000.00 (Rupees one hundred thousand) were donated during the Year 2019 towards the Diamer-Bhasha and Mohmand Dams Fund instituted by the Government of Pakistan.

21. 'Quranic Siparaahs, Punj-Surahs and Quranic Duas', and Books on Islamic Literature

- a. 'AAKF Strategic Vision, 2010-2011' envisioned, by the founding-members' at the time on inception of AAKF, getting rare and useful books on Islamic literature reprinted for wide distribution amongst the English-speaking Muslims. We accordingly got the following reprinted and distributed in fairly large numbers:
 - (1) 'Kashful Mahjub', earliest treatise authored (on 'Sufism') by Hazrat Syed Ali Bin Uthman Al-Hajweri (RH), commonly known as 'Data Ganj Baksh', English translation of which was undertaken very ably by the revered, Hazrat Maulana Wahid Baksh Rabbani (RH), the Eminent Scholar and Sufi-Saint of the 20th Century. This project was undertaken during the period, 2010-2011 without permission, however, from the publishers, who had the proprietary rights for Pakistan. Only a limited number of books were got printed for distribution, as gift, only amongst the family members' and friends. We have now requested

(Late) Maulana Rabbani's son, Muhammad Madni Sial, to allow us proprietary rights for its publishing and distribution in Pakistan and abroad, which is still awaited. If allowed, we shall move forward with full force with its publication and distribution in large numbers within Pakistan and abroad. This time, it will, however, be made into a commercial venture with its total sale proceeds going towards AAKF charitable-welfare activities.

- (2) Revisited, revised and updated English translation of Volume V ('Spiritual Worship') of 'Worship in Islam' co-authored in Urdu by Hazrat Allama Shibli Nomani (RH) and Hazrat Allama Syed Sulaiman Nadwi (RH) was got printed and distributed in fairly large numbers during the Year 2021.
 - (3) 'Quranic Siparaahs, Punj-Surahs and Quranic Duas' were distributed in fairly large numbers in Pakistan and South Africa during the period, 2016 to 2021.
- b. As a policy, printing of 'Siparaahs' and related Islamic literature, and miscellaneous works are done through generation of funds from family members' and friends and not through utilization from 'Zakat-Sadaqa' donations-contributions made by donors for various charitable-welfare activities.

ADDITIONAL PUBLICATIONS AND WORKS UNDERWAY TO BE PUBLISHED DURING THE PERIOD, 2023–2025

22. 'Divine Connection'

- a. This book would basically be a revised second edition of 'Spiritual Worship' published and distributed during the Year 2021. The idea to do so was initiated by a brilliant academican family friend in Pretoria, South Africa, Mr. Faruq Hoosain. He, while commenting on the high-utility and high-value vis-à-vis usefulness of the book, suggested that it needs improvement and further updating to make its intellectual and reading acceptability to a much wider circle of English-speaking Muslims. He suggested that 'Part-II, Ali Akbar Khan Foundation (AAKF)', which is not relevant to almost all general readers, along with some other contents, may be removed and the following added:
 - (1) Meanings, interpretation, and implications of 'Gratitude' in the light of the Holy QURAN and the SUNNAH.
 - (2) Contributions, Impact, and Influence of 'Muslim Civilization' on the World.
- b. Since the new publication would be totally different to the earlier book, 'Spiritual Worship', it was decided to rename it, 'Divine Connection'.

23. 'Muhammad, The Educator'

The book, 'Muhammad, The Educator' was a 'Seminar Study Submitted in Partial Satisfaction of Master of Arts in Education at the University of California, Berkeley, USA in May, 1941' by Mr. Robert L. Gulick Jr. His research work was published in 1953 (one edition only) by the Institute of Islamic Culture, Club Road, Lahore, Pakistan. This book was retrieved from the personal library at Lyallpur (now Faisalabad) of (Late) Chaudhary Ali Akbar Khan, the Honourable Federal Minister of Pakistan for Interior and Kashmir Affairs, 1964-66. This book indicates extremely well the impact, role and contribution of the Muslim Civilization towards the world of today. AAKF intends getting it reprinted for wide distribution.

24.

Award of Sir Cyril Radcliffe, Chairman Punjab Boundary Commission Report Dated 12 August, 1947–Original Documents

- a. At the time of partition of British-India into Pakistan and India, (Late) Chaudhary Ali Akbar Khan, as a young Muslim Advocate from Hoshiarpur District, was appointed by Quaid-e-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah on advice of the Punjab Muslim League, to serve on the 4-members' team appointed for the preparation of the Muslim League case to be presented before the Punjab Boundary Commission. He was chosen to assist Sir Zafar Ullah Khan to present the Muslim League case to the Radcliffe Award Commission; the other two members, who were to assist Sir Zafar Ullah Khan, were Justice Sheikh Din Muhammad and Barrister Khawaja Abdul Rahim. The Punjab Boundary Commission was headed by Sir Cyril Radcliffe, representing the British Crown.
- b. After almost 75-years since our independence, debates and discussions, whether division of Punjab vis-à-vis demarcation of boundaries between Pakistan and India, as it stands today, was justifiable or not, continue to take place at various forums. Resultantly, creating further confusion and doubts in many minds of today.
- c. Two original documents, 'Award of Sir Cyril Radcliffe, Chairman, Punjab Boundary Commission, 12 August, 1947' and 'Memorandum Submitted to the Punjab Boundary Commission on Behalf of the Muslim League' were retrieved from the documents preserved in the library of (Late) Chaudhary Ali Akbar Khan at Faisalabad, after his death on 08 October, 1967.
- d. AAKF intends getting both these documents published for wide distribution. It will, hopefully, help to place the issue for many in the correct perspective. It will also add usefully to knowledge of many modern-day scholars, students of history and others interested in the subject, those who have scant idea, the event having occurred long time ago.

'The Choice (Islam and Christianity)' by Sheikh Ahmed Deedat

AAKF Chief Executive/Secretary, while in Durban, South Africa, visited Sheikh Ahmed Deedat during June, 2001, at a time when he was ailing and bed-ridden. The Sheikh presented him, the Book, 'The Choice (Islam and Christianity)'. It comprises talks and lectures by Sheikh Deedat at various forums within and outside South Africa. As a befitting tribute to his valuable services rendered towards propagation of Islam, the Sheikh was awarded in 1986, the prestigious, 'King Faisal International Award' by the Government of the Royal Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. AAKF intends getting the Book reprinted for wide distribution in Pakistan, for which case to obtain the proprietary rights for Pakistan has been initiated with the Islamic Propagation Centre International (IPCI), South Africa.

MISCELLANEOUS ACTIVITIES

26.

Endowment Fund Investment in Al-Meezan Investment Management Limited, Islamabad

By 20 March, 2022, we shall have deposited Rs.35.00 Million (Rupees thirty-five million) in Al-Meezan. By 30 August, 2023, we hope to deposit additional Rs.50.0 Million (Rupees fifty million), making the total investment of Rs.85.0 Million (Rupees eighty-five million) in Al-Meezan. We intend leaving this amount deposited in Al-Meezan for 02 (two) years, from 20 March, 2022 to 30

June, 2024. Working on the present profit rates announced by the Government of Pakistan, we shall hopefully have invested a total amount of Rs.97,600,000.00 (Rupees ninety seven million six hundred thousand; 09 Crore and 76 Lac) invested with Al-Meezan, Insha-Allah. This amount includes the 'principal amount' and the 'accumulated profit' but does not include Government taxes. With the profit margin accrued on the 'principal amount' each year with effect from 20 March, 2022 to 01 July, 2024, AAKF will be in a fairly happy position to undertake welfare and charitable activities, and to continually build-up as well it's 'Endowment Fund'.

27. Registration With the Government of Punjab

Action has been initiated to immediately register AAKF with the Punjab Charity Commission (Punjab Charity Act, 2022) in accordance with the relevant and applicable law and under the policy guidelines, rules and regulations laid down by the Government of Punjab.

28. Tax Exemption by the Federal Board of Revenue (FBR)

As per the Government of Pakistan policy, rules and regulations, to obtain tax exemption from the FBR, AAKF must be registered with the Pakistan Centre of Philanthropy (PCP) and recommended by them for tax exemption. We intend launching the process of registration with the PCP very soon. We have also initiated the process to obtain NTN (National Tax Number) for AAKF, which is essential for registration with the PCP.

29. Transfer of AAMC Land to AAKF Ownership

The FARD (and mutation) approving transfer by the Revenue Department, Faisalabad of 3.0 (three) Kanals land donated by Ambassador (Retired) Afzal Akbar Khan, on which AAMC Building stands, to ownership of AAKF is in our possession. May Allah Almighty bless him and his family with His mercy, AJR and SAWAB for this act of piety.

30. Renovation of the AAMC Building and Provision of Solar System

Rs.1.5 Million (Rupees one point five million) have been expended on renovation, uplift and maintenance of the AAMC Building this year. This amount was not spent out of the 'Zakat-Sadaqa' donations-contributions made by donors for various charitable-welfare activities but donated by some family members for this very specific purpose. May Allah Almighty bless them with His mercy, AJR and SAWAB for this act of piety. Dr. Waheed Akbar Khan has indicated gifting 10 KVA Solar System, costing approximately Rs.1.0 Million (Rupees one million), to the AAMC sometimes during the coming summers. May Allah Almighty bless him and his family with His mercy, AJR and SAWAB for this act of piety.

31. Memorandum of Association and Articles of Association

Based on our last 12 (twelve) years' working experience since establishment of AAKF, we intend revisiting and updating the AAKF Memorandum of Association and the Articles of Association. This will include the enhanced scope of AAKF welfare and charitable activities, we have been undertaking, and will undertake each year in the future as well.

32. Updating Website

We had launched our website: www.aakf-naweed.org during the Year 2012. We intend updating it during this Financial Year ending 30 June, 2022.

SURAH AL-BAQARAH VERSES 270 TO 274

270. And whatever you spend for spendings (e.g., in 'Sadaqah') or whatever vow you make, be sure Allah knows it all. And for the wrongdoers there are no helpers.
271. If you disclose your 'Sadaqat' (almsgiving), it is well; but if you conceal them and give them to the poor, that is better for you. (Allah) will expiate you some of your sins. And Allah is Well-Acquainted with what you do.
272. Not upon you (Muhammad PBUH) is their guidance, but Allah guides whom He wills. And whatever you spend in good, it is for yourselves, when you spend not except seeking Allah's Face. And whatever you spend in good, it will be repaid to you in full, and you shall not be wronged.
273. (Charity is) for 'Fuqara' (the poor), who in Allah's cause are restricted (from travel), and cannot move about in the land (for trade or work). The one who knows them not, thinks that they are rich because of their modesty. You may know them by their mark, they do not beg of people at all. And whatever you spend in good, surely Allah knows it well.
274. Those who spend their wealth (in Allah's cause) by night and day, in secret and in public, they shall have their reward with their Lord. On them shall be no fear, nor shall they grieve.
